- 2007 Blanc de Noirs with a Teroldego dosage
- Red Tail Ridge Vineyard
- VSP trellis
- Shoot-thinned, leaf-pulled
- 1-2 cluster per shoot

Winemaking

- 118 gallons Pinot Noir, 50% barrel aged and 100% ML
- 18 °C ferment temp
- 18 days to completion of base wine fermentation
- Tirage and bottle fermentation: Sept, 18th, 2008
- Disgorged Feb. 8th, 2011

Tasting Notes

Methode Champagne, extended autolysis. Blanc de Noirs base wine with Teroldego dosage. This bubble has a rich, aromatic profile exhibiting primary notes of toasted brioche, hazelnut, mocha, and coffee, with more delicate notes of sweet red fruit. The aromatics are matched by yeasty and toasted flavors on the palate, dried fruit, finishing in citrus and orange
